In the aftermath of WWII, Gail Halvorsen was a pilot in the US Air Force assigned to deliver supplies via air drop to the city of Berlin. During a ground visit, he saw a group of impoverished children behind the barbed-wire fence that bordered an airlift landing site. He reached into his pocket and took out two sticks of gum to give the children. He watched as they broke gum into as many pieces as possible to share with as many kids as possible. This gave him an idea—every time he flew rations into the city, he brought parcels of candy tied to handkerchiefs as parachutes, to drop as well, wiggling his airplane wings to let the children know it was him. This became known as Operation "Little Vittles" (Little Treats). As the story spread, people and organizations from around the world collected donations to contribute to this effort. Operation Little Vittles helped the world take a step in the direction of healing and demonstrated how contagious kindness can be.
