Comparable to PLEASURE ACTIVISM by adrienne maree brown, WHAT MY BONES KNOW by Stephanie Foo, and HOW TO KEEP HOUSE WHILE DROWNING by KC Davis, THE HYPHENATED LIFE aims to look behind the curtain of what we are pressured to present, and helps readers integrate their public and personal selves. This book delivers solutions for millions of people (nearly 4 in 10 Americans) with intersectional identities to successfully express all sides of who they are in any environment. It also provides context and frameworks for those who hold dominant identities and privilege to better understand the invisible battles that our peers and colleagues are fighting in these liminal spaces. Just as a hyphen draws a connection between two unrelated words, it also creates a new compound word that deserves its own definition.



Arguably the greatest female filmmaker of all time and called "the godmother of the French New Wave," Agnes Varda's career spanned over 70 years, culminating just before her death in 2019 with a Lifetime Achievement Award/Oscar from the Motion Picture Academy. She had made 44 films.

Varda's personal life was as rich and fascinating as her films – a single mother; wife and mother (marriage to filmmaker Jacques Demy (The Umbrellas of Cherbourg)); travels to China, Cuba and California; friendships with filmmakers Jean-Luc Godard and Martin Scorsese, musicians Michel Legrand and Jim Morrison, actors Catherine Deneuve and Harrison Ford, muralists J.R. and Judy Baca, directors Celine Sciamma and Ava DuVernay and figures such as Huey Newton and Andy Warhol; champion of feminist and other progressive causes; grandmother and late-life "fairy godmother of independent film." This long overdue biography will affirm Varda's artistic achievement, place in film history and lasting influence.

Carrie Rickey is an award-winning film critic, art critic and film historian. Formerly the film critic at The Philadelphia Inquirer, she has written for Artforum, The New York Times and Politico.



As the Chicago Tribune's Berlin bureau chief and primary foreign correspondent for Central Europe from 1925 to January 1941, Sigrid Schultz witnessed Hitler's rise to power and was one of the first reporters—male or female—to warn American readers of the growing dangers of Nazism. In The Dragon From Chicago, Toler draws on extensive archival research to unearth the largely forgotten story of Schultz's years spent courageously reporting the news from Berlin. At a time when women reporters rarely wrote front-page stories and her male colleagues saw a powerful unmarried woman as a "freak," Schultz pulled back the curtain on how the Nazis misreported the news to their own people, and how they attempted to control the foreign press through bribery and threats.

Pamela D. Toler is the author of several books and often looks at history from the other side of the battlefield or the gender line.
