But a contract cannot be broken, except at a devil's mercy.

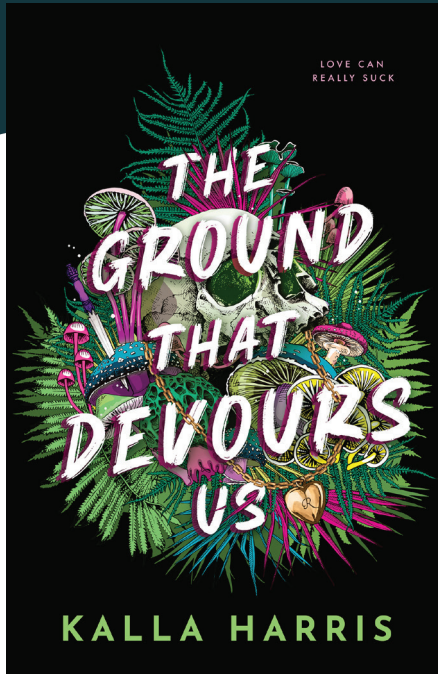

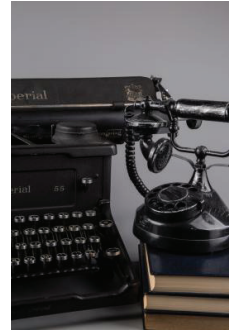
THREADWEAVER
