His music, like that of Little Richard, Ray Charles, Aretha Franklin, and James Brown, has defined the American experience, and has inspired countless artists who are household names today. Debuting in the late 1950s, the Isley Brothers remain cultural giants; icons of funk, R&B, and soul; and their 2022 album included major contemporary collaborators from Beyoncé to Snoop Dogg. Their catalog is among the most-sampled in hip-hop history, and Ronald is a proverbial godfather to many past and present stars.
