



Description

The Alchemy of the Broken Blade is a book born from extremes: from death row and solitary confinement, from spiritual breakdown and resurrection, from years spent clawing his way out of despair and into a life he could stand inside again. And through that process, Echols discovered a path rooted in discipline, ritual, devotion, and presence.

This book is an amalgamation of Eastern and Western philosophies, braided together into a single spiritual technology for transformation. It's structured in four parts to mirror the four steps of the alchemical process:

- **Deconstruction**—breaking down the false self and recognizing internal enemies
- **Reconstruction**—rebuilding through tools like Magick, Alchemy, Tang Soo Do, Kaizen, and Bushido
- **Integration**—putting knowledge into practice in daily life
- **Becoming**—focusing on embodied presence, emphasizing ongoing practice

The author shares personal stories of finding the "Way" in prison and after his release. He also stresses that the external form of practice is less important than the internal relationship to it, advocating for engagement with the world and finding the sacred in the mundane.

About the Author(s)

Damien Echols is an American author who first became known as one of three teenagers, the West Memphis Three, convicted of a triple murder in 1994 despite the lack of physical evidence connecting them to the crime. New DNA evidence secured his release from death row in 2011, after which Echols authored several autobiographical and spiritual/magickal books. He has been featured in multiple books, documentaries, and podcasts about his spiritual works and the West Memphis Three case. Echols spent his time on death row studying Buddhism and was ordained in the Rinzai tradition of Zen by a Japanese Zen master. An avid reader, he became interested in ceremonial magic and spent most of the 18 years in prison studying magic.


Rachel Pollack (1945–2023) was the leading light and foremost influence on modern tarot. Her bestselling book *Seventy-Eight Degrees of Wisdom*, first published in 1980 and never out of print, is widely described as the “Bible of Tarot.” She was also a great influence upon the science fiction, fantasy, and comics communities, as well as being a trailblazer within the transgender community.

A master of many genres, Pollack is renowned for her run of issues #64–87 of *Doom Patrol* (Vertigo Comics), where she created the first transgender superhero. A prolific author of both fiction and nonfiction, her other books include *A Walk through the Forest of Souls*, *Unquenchable Fire*, *Godmother Night*, and *The Fissure King*. She was the creator of the *Shining Tribe Tarot* and wrote the guidebooks for numerous other decks, including *The Vertigo Tarot* and *Salvador Dali's Tarot*. Pollack taught at the famed Omega Institute for over thirty years.

The Tarot Book of the Dead is structured as a chthonic journey, honoring the transformational paths in myths of descent, from Persephone's underworld journey to Orpheus's search for Eurydice. The book is divided into four parts. Each part is a collection of chapters that are headlined by a Major Arcana card that acts as a gatekeeper. That Major Arcana card offers an invitation, followed by a lesson to be learned, a challenge (activity) to do, and, finally, permission to go on to the next gatekeeper. Through this mythic journey, readers will confront their own relationship to death, learn tarot mediumship, engage in grief work, and explore psychopomp practices.

A reader could use this book for their own personal work, but death doulas, grief workers, hospice caregivers, and mediums will also find guidance. It offers an initiatory process that functions as a how-to manual in which the reader will deepen their practice with tarot and death.
