Making Demons Bright (Holly Dell Demons 1) Casey Blair

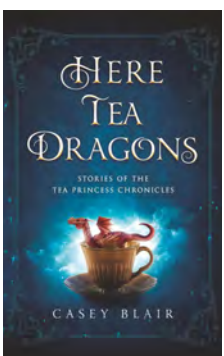
It's up to a burned out project manager and a fire demon to save Christmas...
